









Proportion of patients



The recruitment proportion is calculated as number of patients participating divided by number of actual beds. In most units nearly all patients present were recruited and this increases the validity of the results for this unit.







Female gender proportion







Age distribution
















Weight loss before admission





Lunch eaten on nutritionDay













Lunch eaten on nutritionDay

Death in hospital before 30 days following ND Specialty









Please **use only** to determine which group of patients predominates within your patient population compared with the reference specialty.





- ND increases awareness
- ND information:
 - -High prevalence of weight loss & reduced intake before admission in hospitalised patients
 - Large effect on hospital resource utilisation
 - -High variability between units
